We commend Carequality's <u>recently announced plan</u> to align with TEFCA. Carequality's Treatment Use Cases will reflect the definitions used in TEFCA, for example, and new delegate policies will allow healthcare organizations to review and approve organizations requesting records on their behalf, just as they can under TEFCA.

By the end of 2024, our goal is that the full Epic community will have committed to transition to TEFCA with plans to be live by the end of 2025. Epic Nexus makes it easy for our customers to join TEFCA, and many have <u>already signed up</u>. Epic will continue to support our customers' connectivity through Carequality during the transition to help ensure the ongoing success of national healthcare interoperability.

100% of the Epic community participates in the Carequality framework, which today connects more than 70% of U.S. hospitals, 50,000+ clinics, and more than 600,000 care providers. TEFCA is the nation's best opportunity to get the remaining 30% of U.S. hospitals off the sidelines and reinforce trust between data exchange networks and care organizations.
